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## 2025 COMMITTEE REPORTS

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**POSITION: President – Madonna Corless**

### 2025 OVERVIEW

2025 has been a very successful year for QC. Beginning the year with our new executive and committee. I would like to thank each member of the committee for their tireless efforts across the year. It is not an easy task but with many people contributing and offering to do even the smallest jobs to assist in the running of our association it makes a huge difference.

I would also like to thank our association captains Lucy Wilton and Tilly Beehag who have shown wonderful leadership and commitment to the association this year.

SSA and JSA were again very successful tournaments for us. Along with our elite competitions including GBNL and M League, I believe it has been our most successful year for results. QC cup still leads the way with our school's competition and in 2026 will see the inclusion of the QC All Schools Competition.

We continue to run our Player Development Program and our U11 Pre Rep programs that have increased in numbers of participants and has shown to be a very successful pathway to our Representative program for our players. As we head into the trail season for 2026, we hope that 2026 will be even more successful.

I will continue to work with our regional associations and Netball Qld to ensure the best outcomes for QC. Our ongoing relationship with NQ, namely Paula Toonan and Izzy Marks continues to thrive. I know that they have the best interests of QC at heart.

I have been working on updating our constitution with two QC parents who are lawyers and work in this field. I have planned to meet with them during summer season to discuss the final changes.

Currently, I am happy to continue to fill the President role in 2026.

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**POSITION: Treasurer, Kerri Wilton**

QC is on track to remain profitable in 2025 and has run on a positive cash basis year-round. Our representative programs - JSA, SSA, GBNL and M League - are operated with the intent of running purely for the benefit of players with essentially no profit made from player fees and with costs usually subsidised to some extent by QC.

QC Cup, Summer Season and PDP are intended to generate profits to run our organisation and to assist in funding our representative programs.

#### QC Cup

- Net profit \$28k up from \$22k in 2024
- Team registration fees increased to \$140 (from \$120), comp fully booked
- Increased expenses due to portaloos and addition of medals for players

#### Summer Season

- Projecting NP circa \$56k down from \$64k
- Teams registered on par to 2024 but slightly lower number of players on avg per team



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- Court hire was down approx. \$5k last year due to multiple cancelled weeks and rounds due to weather

- Context – prior to DPNA adding a summer comp, NP circa \$80k

#### PDP

- Concerned about numbers for this – starting in 10 days
- 49 registered as opposed to 144 last year
- Need approx. 80 more registrations to reach the goal of \$10k profit

#### Investments

- Additional \$10k added to term deposits now totalling \$53k
- Managed fund earned just over 5% last financial year, now totalling \$710k

#### What worked well:

- Payment plans on Majestri
- Uniforms online

#### What did not work well:

- Fairplay / PlayOn! Sports vouchers – process good for players but manual process for me, significant increase in usage from less than 10 last year to 123 this year. Don't think there's any real solution to this.

#### Suggestions:

- Recruit a PDP convenor so this can be organised earlier and advertised more heavily
- Addition of All Schools Champs – promote this year and early next year so schools have in calendar
- Recruit a fundraising convenor and have a plan for the year
- Should we consider a rebate on player fees for committee members?

#### Upcoming priorities:

- 2026 budgets including Townsville SSA
  - Review ability to add funds to Term Deposits
  - Review BT annual investment report and whether review with advisor required

**1. What worked well**

- ☐ *Came into roll for final 2 carnivals and State Age – Felt lead up went well. Unsure of survey results but often told by parents that they liked the shorter season. No major issues at JSA.*

**2. What did not work well and how to improve**

- *Managers – Majority were fantastic, only a couple of concerns raised by coaches about their assigned managers and their expectations.*
- *Fruit – Trialled teams bringing fruit to share on water table. Majority left at the end of JSA, wouldn't suggest doing this again.*

- *Tent - – Determine as a committee and communicate / remind on who is allowed in the tents. Is this in writing? Can it be reviewed to set clear boundaries and expectations and be distributed? Communicate / remind regularly.*
  - *Managers – Do we have a document in place for Managers to read and sign? Outline to Managers – Association expectations, the role, coaches' input?*
  - *Food – Fruit wasn't successful. Rethink if food is required, if so – individual sized closed snacks.*
  - *Association Image – Selections, transparency, who we align with (if anyone), "Catholic" raises q's – To be discussed ...*

#### 2025 OVERVIEW

Seven (7) QC Teams entered 2025 GBNL Comp:

- U16 Black – 4th in Div 3
- U16 Green – 2nd in Div 2
- U18 Black – 7th in Div 2
- U18 Green – 2nd in Div 2
- U23 Green – 6th in Div 2
- Open Black – 5th in Div 2



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- Open Green – 4th in Div 1

#### 1. What worked well

- New GBNL coaches – Maia, Lisa, Andrea
- 4 out of 7 teams made finals
- Lucky with weather this season – no disruptions due to rain
- Friendships formed
- Opportunities for younger players to fill in for older teams at time

#### 2. What did not work well and how to improve

- Lack of emergency players
- Captains never announced/finalised
- Official photos – one team missing
- Trainings inconsistent across teams
- Not much collaboration with other teams
- Not enough training (only 1.5 hrs per week) / no strength or gym
- Coach absences
- Big one – the “elite”/privilege/pride of playing GBNL was almost non-existent this year, especially among the younger players. It’s been lost.
- Umpires – not organised – not enough – will get fined next time

#### 3. Detail what did not work well and suggestions for improvement for 2025

- Perhaps all “rejection” emails get asked if they wish to be placed/registered on our emergency player squad / cold call players who don’t sign up for GBNL but have previously played as ask them to join the emergency player squad / get names on the lists early
- Clear outline of expectation/guideline for all coaches e.g. deadlines for Captain announcements – alternatively, make it optional. But make it clear.
- More structure around training sessions and expectations
- Floating coach at every training session so can easily fill in if a coach is away?
- Need a strength session added / need a deeper level of training otherwise no different to club – Netball Revolution gym and S&C Coach makes sense. Can be optional extra for GBNL players if you don’t want to make it mandatory. Specifically S&C FOR netballers. Supports injury prevention.

#### 2025 END OF SEASON REPORT AND 2026 PLAN

- Extra Training sessions (did more training/game prep for SSA) – potential a second “optional” training session open to all players as group training / or throughout GBNL season conduct optional specific training nights...e.g.targeting shooters one week, defenders another, middies another... Coaches take turns doing the extra sessions
- Need to secure umpires early – umpire convenor?
- Supporting/teaming up with/advocating with places like NR and Albion should be viewed as positive. Goes both ways. Exposure. Reputation. Work together for the betterment of players and each separate entity.
- Need to communicate higher expectations to parents and players early on. Starting at trials/in offer letters/first “all-team” training session.
- Mindset session or motivational speaker / Gabi Simpson was great / another player – at least once, if not twice, per season?



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- Need to elevate the GBNL experience.
